SHOULD I REPORT TO SCHOOL?

Have you tested **POSITIVE** for COVID-19?

NO,

Have you been in contact with someone who is probable positive or has tested **POSITIVE** for COVID-19?

Do you have any COVID-19 symptoms?

YES, I have.

Quarantine for 10 days from the first date of symptoms OR 10 days from your test date.

Were you within 6 feet of a probable/positive case for 15 or more cumulative minutes in a 24 hour period or in a classroom?

YES, I was.

Stay at home, monitor your symptoms, **AND contact your healthcare provider for evaluation and need for testing.**

Report to school.

You may return to school with a note from your doctor when you are symptom-free.

Quarantine for 14 days after the last exposure to the probable/positive case of COVID-19 **AND** monitor for symptoms. If at any point the temperature is 100.4° or higher, or symptoms develop, contact your healthcare provider and notify your school nurse. You may return to school with a note from your doctor.

You may return to school with a note from your doctor when you are symptom-free.
